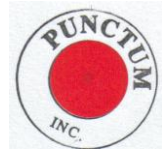

## **ABOUT *In-Habit International* Host Organisations**

**In choosing a Host Organisation you have 2 options:**

### **1. A Punctum network Host Organisation:**

Through Punctum's arts initiatives and networks, we are closely linked with several Host Organisations based in Mexico, France and Brazil. In collaboration with Punctum, each of these Host Organisations will participate in the application selection process should you wish to undertake arts research and cultural exchange with them.

Descriptions of the arts research and cultural exchange programs of these Host Organisations is attached. To assist your understanding of their activities and their location, we have included their web site details.

### **2. Propose a Host Organisation through your own initiative.**

You may wish to propose a Host Organisation for your arts research and cultural exchange. If so, you will need to make individual contact with your self – initiated Host Organisation well ahead of completing an *In-Habit International* application.

We require a letter of support or invitation from the proposed Host Organisation attached to your application, stating the nature of the arts research and cultural exchange opportunity they are providing.

You will need to provide them with the 'ABOUT *In-Habit International*' information and draw their attention to the section on 'What does the Host Organisation contribute?' *In-Habit International* applications involving a self initiated Host Organisation are ineligible without this letter of support.

***In-Habit International* applicants seeking to collaborate with a self-initiated Host Organisation should discuss their proposal with Punctum's Artistic Director prior to completing an *In-Habit International* application.**

### **Host Organisation's letter of support**

Your self-initiated Host Organisation's letter should be 1 page on letterhead, dated, to include a 500 word description of its overall activities, agreement to host you, and an outline of your role and the nature of the arts research and cultural exchange activities in which you will be engaged with them.

**As applications close on January 3rd 2012, you will need to receive the letter before this date.**
